



## Summer Camp Programs

### John D. MacArthur Beach State Park

Camp is from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. (Care provided from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.)

The focus of the Summer Camp Program is to educate our youth about the preservation, restoration, and interpretation of the natural and cultural assets of John D. MacArthur Beach State Park.

Our goals are to help each camper appreciate their natural surroundings and take an active role in the stewardship of our environment and provide opportunities that stimulates the development of each camper's self-esteem.

#### Programs:

**Eco-Explorers** summer camp is designed for children who have completed second or third grade. The focus of the program is to introduce the campers to the basic environmental concepts such as the habitat components, life cycles, food chains and webs, carrying capacity, and camouflage through interactive games and activities utilizing the coastal ecosystems of John D. MacArthur Beach State Park. Campers will also participate in outdoor recreational activities such as swimming, and kayaking. Cost is \$175 per week plus t-shirts and rash guards. The following are the weeks for the Eco-Explorers program:

**Junior Rangers** summer camp is designed for children who have completed fourth or fifth grade. The focus of the program is exploration of the Maritime Hammock, Estuary, Beach and Dune and the Rock Reef at John D. MacArthur Beach State Park. Campers will snorkel, swim and kayak throughout the week. Cost is \$200 per week plus t-shirts and rash guards. The following are the weeks for the Junior Rangers program:

**Marine Biology** Summer Camp is designed for children who have completed sixth, seventh, or eighth grade. The focus of the program is to explore the organisms of the coastal ecosystems by participating in scientific investigations such as fish counts on the reef, seagrass survey, biodiversity of the estuary and restoration of estuary systems. This program utilizes a marine biology professor from PBA to teach this program. Cost is \$225 per week plus t-shirts and rash guards. The following are the weeks for the Marine Biology program:
